### 2021 USPA Regional President's Cup

SANTA BARBARA, CA. (September 22nd, 2021) The USPA Regional Presidents Cup is an historic eight goal tournament played across the United States. Five teams competed for the Santa Barbara Polo Club President's Cup title. After three rounds of bracket play, Klentner Ranch and Rancho Polo/Chogan met in the final on the main field in front of a large audience in the US Polo Assn Grandstands.

After landing in three finals during the Rincon tournament series, Rancho Polo/Chogan have been knocking on the door of victory and were hungry for a win. This showed as Rancho Polo's Jason Crowder put a goal on the board in the first seconds of the match defeating Klentner ranch 4-1 in the first chukker. With that deficit in mind, Klentner Ranch held steady keeping themselves in the game with steady penalties. The first half finished in favor of Rancho Polo/Chogan 9-5.

Klentner Ranch scored their first goal from the field in the 4th chukker, but it was no match for Crowder's scoring power. Crowder scored two goals from the field in the 4th chukker on Best Playing Pony, Fanta, keeping their lead by four goals. In the final chukkers of the match Klentner Ranch's Jesse Bray began to put his team back in the game, but it was too little too late as the clock struck zero and the game finished with a final score of 14-12, an outstandingly high scoring game for the eight goal level.

Along with the honors of owning the Best Playing Pony, Fanta, Jason Crowder was awarded as the Most Valuable Player for scoring 10 goals in the six chukkers of play. Rancho Polo/Chogan took home the beautiful bridles as prizes and a large check of \$2,500 courtesy of the United States Polo Association's Tournament Stimulus Package.
